

Town of Fowlerton Council Meeting
June 9, 2025, at the Town Office

The meeting was called to order at 7:02 pm. Councilmember Joe T. Seward and Steve Turner were present. Clerk-Treasurer Michelle Roberts was also present. Minutes for the May meeting were reviewed. Joe Seward made a motion to accept the minutes, and Steve Turner seconded the motion. With a voice vote the motion was approved.

Financial Reports read.

NEW BUSINESS:

Clerk-Treasurer Michelle Roberts gave the council a proposed ordinance in regard to recovering all court costs and legal fees incurred in pursuing all ordinance violations as the town does not have one in effect. Town Attorney, Kyle Persinger, drafted the writing in the ordinance that was presented.

Michelle Roberts made a motion to adopt Ordinance No. 02-2025 on the First Reading and Steve Turner seconded the motion. With a unanimous voice vote the motion was passed. Michelle Roberts made a motion to suspend the rules and consider Ordinance No. 02-2025 for adoption and Steve Turner seconded the motion. With a unanimous voice vote the motion was passed. Michelle Roberts made a motion to adopt Ordinance No. 02-2025 on final reading and Steve Turner seconded the motion. With a unanimous vote, the Ordinance was adopted. Ordinance No. 02-2025 will be published as needed.

Roberts stated she will be out of town on the date of the scheduled August council meeting. The council stated that the August council meeting will be pushed back one week to August 18, 2025, as it would be most beneficial if Roberts were in attendance especially since the live streaming will be so new to the council. Roberts will post a sign on the door and make a post on the town website informing the community that the date has been changed.

OLD BUSINESS:

Resident Dave Hoskins was present and gave an offer for purchase of lot at 222 N. Cleveland Street for \$3500.00. Seward told Hoskins that the board would look over the offer and get back with him as one of the council members was not present this evening.

Roberts reminded the council that starting the July council meeting we will be live streaming on YouTube. The meeting agenda will be published on the town website prior and approved council minutes will also be published after each meeting starting in July.

Vouchers were presented and signed for approval.

With no further business, Steve Turner made a motion to adjourn, and Joe Seward seconded the motion. With a voice vote the meeting was adjourned.
