ORDINANCE NO. 6-2004

An Ordinance providing penalties for violations of Ordinance No. 5-2004, the sewer use ordinance of the Town of Fowlerton, Indiana

- Section 1. (a) Any person found to be violating any provision of Ordinance No. 5-2004, the sewer use ordinance of the Town of Fowlerton (the "Town"), shall be served by the Town with written notice stating the nature of the violation and providing a reasonable time limit for the satisfactory correction thereof. The offender shall, within the period of time stated in such notice, permanently cease all violations.
- (b) Any person who shall continue any violation beyond the time limit provided for in Section 1(a) shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and in conviction thereof shall be fined in an amount not exceeding Five Hundred Dollars (\$500) for each violation. Each day in which any such violation shall continue shall be deemed a separate offense.
- (c) Any person violating any of the provisions of Ordinance No. 5-2004 is liable to the Town for any expense, loss or damage occasioned by the Town by reason of such violation.
- Section 2. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed. The invalidity of any section, clause, sentence, or provision of this ordinance shall not affect the validity of any other part of this ordinance which can be given effect without such invalid part or parts.

Section 3. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication as provided by law.
